Swimming Safely

- Do not swim without an adult present
- Do not run near water
- Do not dunk another person
- Do not push or shove another person
- Do not play in water over your head until you can swim WELL.
- Do not depend on flotation devices; learn to swim
- Do not jump into water unless you know it is safe.
- Do not swim when it is stormy
- Only swim in places where you have permission to swim

Beach Safely

- Learn to swim
- Watch out for big waves
- Look before you dive
- Always swim with an adult
- Learn to float
- Swim between the flags
- Swim with a crowd
- Get out when you are cold
- Don't go out too deep
- Floating toys can be dangerous
- Watch your little brother/sister
- If in trouble do not panic
- A raised arm is a signal for help

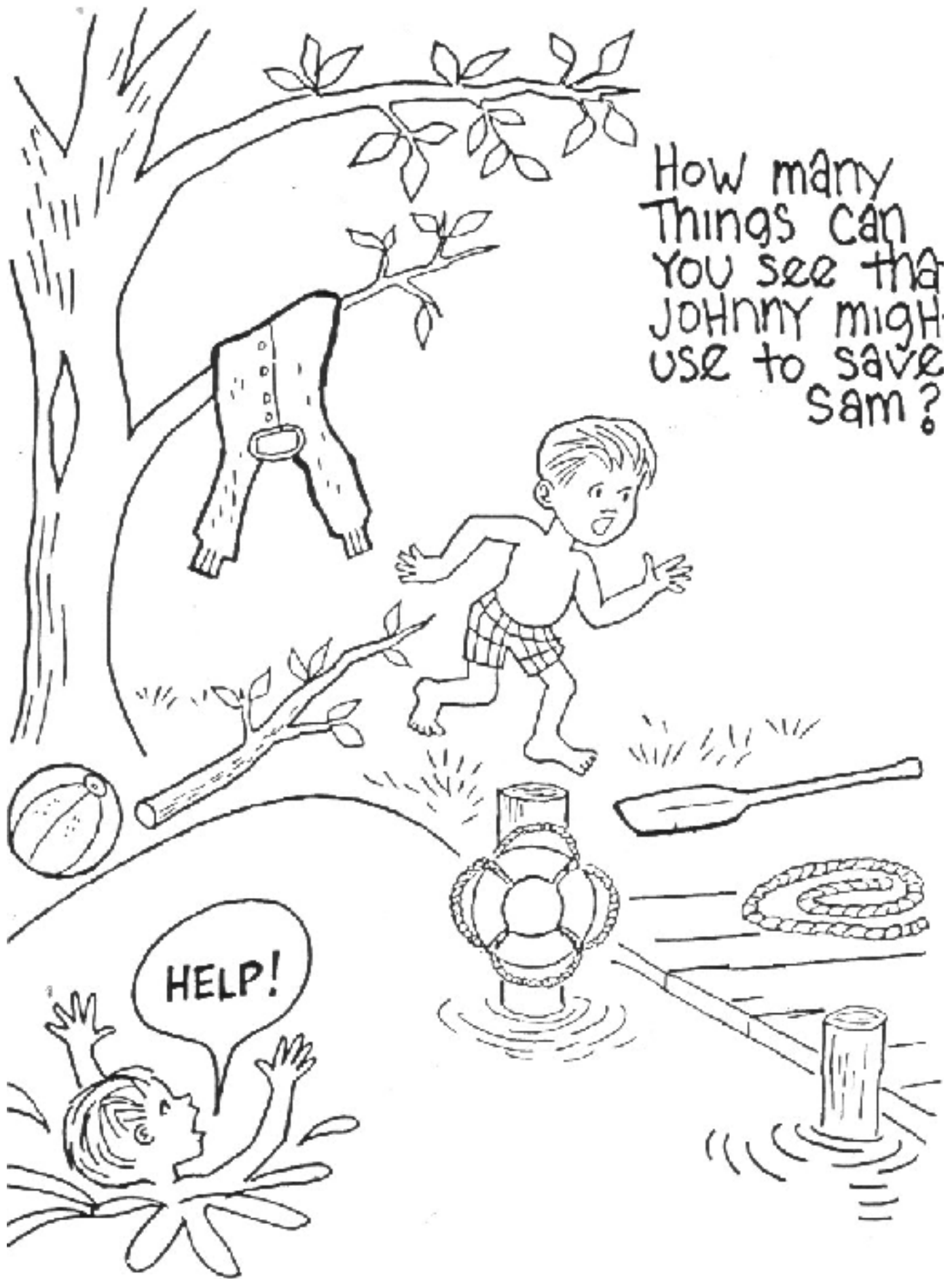

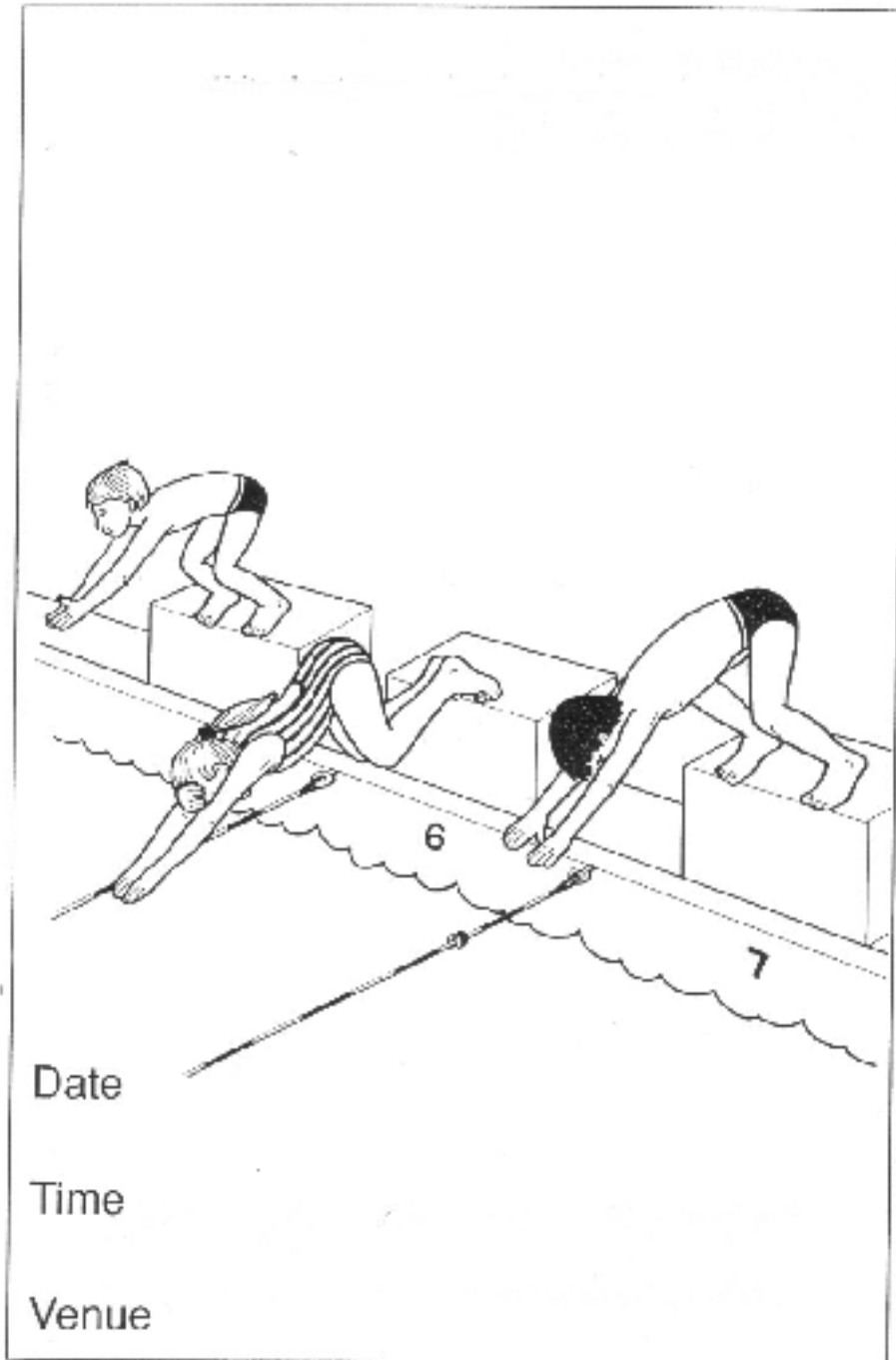
