

Basic - Reinforcement

Reading -My Bookmark

Resources Needed:

Strips of card and coloured pencils

Activity

Sit the children so that they are comfortable to work with coloured pencils (at a table, or on their stomachs on the floor)

Say

Let's make a bookmark so we'll know where we're up to in the book we're going to read this week. Let them make whatever shape or colour bookmark they like (a green bookworm would be an idea). Ask them to write their name on the back of the book mark.

Debriefing Questions:

Do you think you'll be able to read (hear for the younger ones) some of your story every day? What time of the day would be best for you? Do you think you could tell us something about your book at the next meeting?
